Rabbi Dr. Donniel Hartman is the president of the Shalom Hartman Institute, a think tank in Jerusalem. He is the founder of some of the most extensive education, training and enrichment programs for scholars, educators, rabbis, and lay leaders in Israel and North America. Rabbi Hartman is a prominent essayist, blogger and lecturer on issues of Israeli politics, policy, Judaism, and the Jewish community.



He has a Ph.D. in Jewish philosophy from Hebrew University, an M.A. in political philosophy from New York University, an M.A. in religion from Temple University, and Rabbinic ordination from the Shalom Hartman Institute.

Rabbi Hartman is the author of *The Boundaries of Judaism* and *Putting God Second: How to Save Religion from Itself*; co-editor of *Judaism and the Challenges of Modern Life*; co-author of *Spheres of Jewish Identity*; and lead author of *Speaking iEngage: Creating a New Narrative Regarding the Significance of Israel for Jewish Life*. He is currently completing his next book, entitled *Who are the Jews?*

He is married to Adina, is the father of three children and has two grandchildren.
