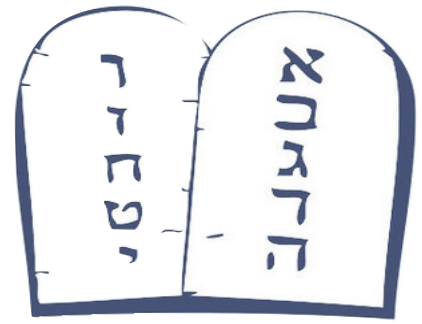


SATURDAY NIGHT, JUNE 8

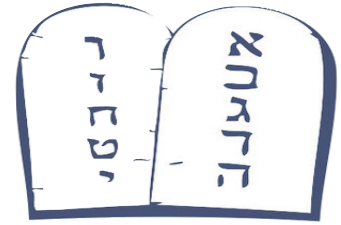
